a) **From the John Paul II International Airport Kraków-Balice to the City Centre**

There are two ways to get to the city center, by:

Taxi: you can use following companies

ICAR + 48 12 653 55 55 (around 40-50 PLN)

MEGA TAXI +48 196 25 (around 40-50 PLN)

BARBAKAN TAXI +48 196 61 (around 60-80 PLN).

Airport Taxi (around 60-80 PLN) which waits outside the arrival and departure hall.

Public transportation: Bus stops within the airport's premises are located near the T1 international terminal (departure hall). **Due to the fact that the airport is under renovation, the arrival hall is in walking distance with the departure hall where the city bus stop is located (around 5 min walk).** You can also get there with free of charge AIRPORT SHUTTLE BUS.

Krakow Airport is served by two regular bus lines: 208 and 292. You can find detailed timetable here: <http://www.krakowairport.pl/en/passenger,c70/transport-parking,c76/how-to-get-to-krakow-airport,c77/by-public-bus,a198.html>.

Single trip is 4 PLN (regular price) and 2 PLN (reduced price).

Tickets can be purchased from:

- RELAY newsagent located in terminal T1 and T2,
- the ticket machine at the bus stop (payment in cash or with credit/debit card),
- the authorized ticket machines found on 292 line buses (payment in cash – coins only),
- the bus driver, in case of lack or failure of ticket machine (single tickets only, payment in cash - the exact amount of money).

Note: The ticket must be validated when getting on the bus.

To get to Floriańska Guesthouse you need to take **bus number 292 and get off at bus stop called: Dworzec Główny Wschód** (it's the last stop of this line). Then you go about 100 m to Railway Station that is connected with shopping mall Galeria Krakowska, you go through shopping mall and take an exit to Pawia St. (at the map below two red arrows will lead you to Pawia St.). You take Pawia St. and walk the street till underground pedestrian tunnel, you go through it. You will then keep going straight, pass green area (see the second map below), take Pijarska St., turn first street left – it's Floriańska street and the guesthouse is number 49.

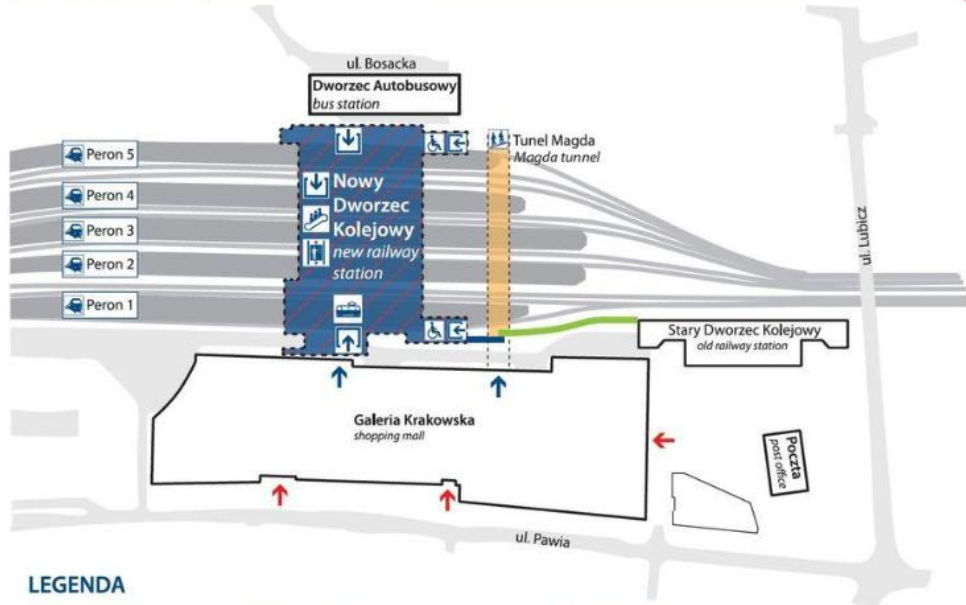

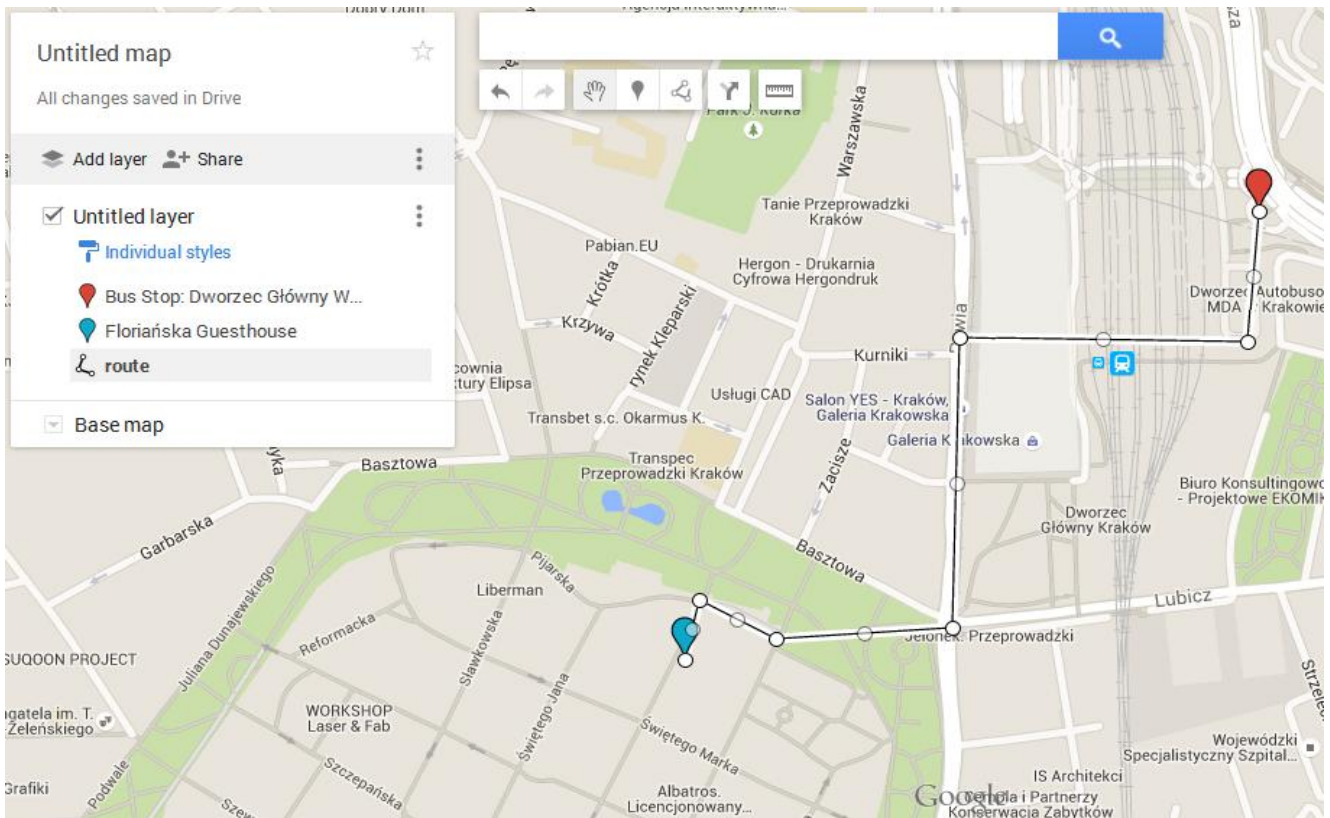

If you are going to arrive at the Bus/Railways station the route to the guesthouse is the same. You need to get to the shopping mall Galeria Krakowska and then take one of the exits to Pawia St.

Unfortunately there is not a convenient public transportation connection to Floriańska St., so if you cannot and do not want to walk you can take a taxi, located at Pawia St, next to the exit from shopping mall.

b) Getting around the city

- You can use public transportation to explore Krakow; single ride is 3,80 PLN (regular price) and 1,90 PLN (reduced price); one day ticket is 15,00 PLN (regular price) and 7,50 PLN (reduced price)
- You can also rent a bike. There are a lot of rental places in the city center:

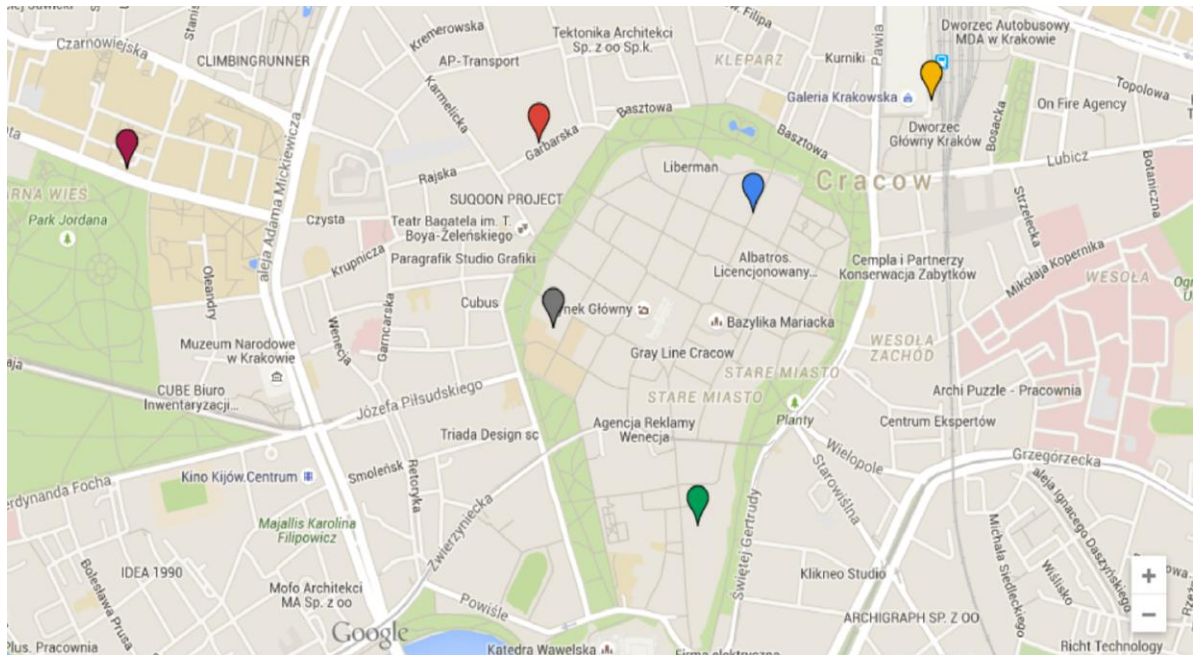
